1. Rule C.3.4.

Following a small change in the last World Sailing RRS (21-24)

- C.3.4 If the bowsprit cannot be removed, the race committee may give a derogation based on a written request.
 In that case the bowsprit shall not be considered as part of the hull or equipment when the boat finishes.
- Contrary to the World Sailing RRS, such bowsprit shall not be considered as a part of the hull or equipment in the definition of "Clear Astern and Clear Ahead; Overlap"

2. Rule B.3.

- When the HTCE introduced that rule (IRC rating limitation at 0.965) one boat had to proceed with modifications to reach it.
- Today no boat is above 0.964
- In order to move towards the spirit of this rule the board proposes to vote the adaptation of our rule B.3. to 0.964 as no one will suffer any prejudice.





Organizers of the 2023 HTCC

(40 years after the last HTC in Hankø)



Half Ton Class Norway has entered into a collaboration with Hankø Yacht Club (HYC) and The Royal Norwegian Sailing Association (KNS) on a Reunion WC on Hankø for 1/2 ton in the period 13-19.8.2023.

40 years after the historic World Championships on Hankø in 1983, where our dear King Harald finished in 4th place with the half Fram VIII.

HYC provides all facilities at its facility on Hankø available during the championship and the Royal Norwegian Sailing Association will ensure the sailing implementation with all its weight and experience as a regatta organizer, as they did in 1983.

With these on the team, we are sure that we will put 1/2 ton sailing emphatically on the map and that Hankø is the place to be for any dedicated 1/2 ton sailor in August next year.



The island Hankø

Hankø is a tranquil island that was once the hunting territory of the Master of the manor Elingaard. About a century ago fallow deer were imported from Denmark and released on Hankø. You may still meet fallow deer when walking around the island. The island also has a long history as a resort. The hotel was built in 1877 as a bath, and Seilerkroa (The Sailor's Inn) was erected in 1883.

Hankø is a pedestrian island. The only car on the island is the one used by the hotel to transport newly arrived guests from the ferry to the hotel.

Hankø's history as a sailing and regatta venue goes back to the 1880s. The monument on the way out to the racecourse is a memorial of King Olav V, who spent many decades sailing at Hankø.



Hankø Yacht Club

Hankø Yacht Club aims to promote national and international sailing in the waters around Hankø in Fredrikstad municipality. You find HYC at the far end of Husebukta.



Access to the club is by ferry from the town of Vestre Vikane on the mainland or by own boat.

Accomodation

There are guest berthes available at Hankø Yacht Club, Hankø Marina, Fredrikstad Yacht Club and Seilerkroa for those who have a boat to live in during the championship.

Sea stalls:

We are in dialogue with the owners of 19 sea stalls 150 meters from HYC about renting these. Each sea stalls can house 6 people and has cooking facilities and a great view of Husebukta.

We have been promised clarification on how many of the owners who will rent out at the beginning of December.



Summerhouses for rent:

There are private summerhouses available for rent at Hankø and the nearby area on Airbnb.no & Finn.no.

Hankø Hotel and SPA is the only hotel on the Island. The hotel offers a SPA department with swimming pool. There is a 7 minutes walk from the hotel til Hankø Yacht Club
